NATURE CENTRAL

- As directed, complete the inventorying, documentation and mapping of protected rural landscapes in Central Alberta within 100 km of Red Deer
- In conjunction with the Education and Program Coordinator, lead nature tours as well as place-based experiential, family-oriented programs
- Promote nature appreciation and the thoughtful exploration, non-consumptive use and ecological understanding of these protected areas
- Develop, promote and lead Citizen Science programs and initiatives
- Cultivate beneficial partnerships with the stakeholders of protected areas in Central Alberta

HABITAT STEWARD

- Promote the program to recognize landowners who conserve habitat on private property
- Maintain a database of landowners and habitat descriptions, deliver signs, arrange field trips, meet and interview landowners, write engaging stories about private conservancy,

- Ability to conduct basic plant inventories and bird point/transect counts
